WINTER WORLD TRANSPLANT GAMES & THE NICHOLAS CUP 2012**

The official dates of the Winter World Transplant Games are from the 4-9 March 2012. However, we are offering two extra nights (3 and 9 March) to anyone who wishes to come and join this celebration of the gift of life and homage to our donors.

Anyone who had had an organ or bone marrow transplant can come and compete in downhill ski, cross country ski, snowboard and biathlon competitions. Those who have never skied before can compete in curling and snowshoe competitions, where previous experience is not absolutely necessary.

The Nicholas Cup ski camp welcomes transplant children aged 4-17 who have never skied before for a week long fully-supervised camp. A seven year-old boy from California, Nicholas Green, was killed by highway robbers in 1994 while vacationing in Italy with his family. His parents agreed to donate his organs and corneas, which went to seven people.

The Games are not only about competing. Anyone who has never been to the World Transplant Games can come for the first time and learn to ski, or simply enjoy the breath-taking scenery of the Swiss Alps and meet people from around the world who have lived through the same experiences. Friends and family are also welcome and we have negotiated special offers with the ski schools and for ski hire to make this a fun and affordable experience for everyone.

Our nearest airport is Geneva International, but there are many direct flights to Zurich from around the world and regular train transfers run to Sion, where our team will collect participants. Anzère is well placed in the middle of Europe to visit Paris and Milan by train and there are many airlines flying directly to many interesting destinations from Geneva. We are also a stone's throw away from Zermatt and the Matterhorn.
